

WREN'S FCC Scottish Action Fund Accepting Applications

The FCC Scottish Action Fund provides funding under the Scottish Landfill Communities Fund (SLCF).

Grants of between £2,000 and £100,000 are available to a variety of not for profit organisations in Scotland, such as charities, community councils, church or community organisations and voluntary groups. Groups must be constituted and have a bank account to apply for the funding, which is aimed at supporting a range of applications that align with the SLCF's Objects.

The objects, which are fully explored in the guidance notes available to download on WREN's website, are as follows:

- Land Reclamation (Object A): The reclamation, remediation, restoration or other operation on land to facilitate economic, social or environmental use.
- Community Recycling (Object B): Community based recycling, re-use and waste prevention projects.
- Public Amenities and Parks (Object C): To provide, maintain or improve a public park or other public amenity.
- Biodiversity (Object D): The conservation or promotion of biological diversity through the provision, conservation, restoration or enhancement of a natural habitat or the maintenance or recovery of a species in its natural habitat.
- Historic Buildings (Object E): The maintenance, repair or restoration of a building, other structure or a site of archaeological interest which is a place of religious worship, or a site of historic or architectural or archaeological interest and is open to the public.

It is important that for all Objects, work is targeted on a specific site at a single location. All projects must be for the benefit of the general public.

The final 2017 round closes 17 November 2017 (5pm). The fund will then re-open on 6 December 2017 and close on 28 February 2018.
